Galactica Supernova

Heesen's biggest yacht to date stole the show, awarded Best Exterior Design (courtesy of Espen Oeino) and Finest New Superyacht. Those that couldn't get access to this much-in-demand 70m creation made do with a virtual tour at the Salle Eiffel of the Hotel Hermitage, admiring the 6m infinity pool, helipad-cum-cinema and everything in between.

Sybaris





This sprawling 70m sailing yacht berthed up next to the show's new Car Deck, where onlookers could admire Perini Navi's second largest yacht to date (after the Maltese Falcon) from the driving seat of the latest McLaren. The boat took home an award for her interiors, by Peter Hawrylewicz and Ken Lieber.

WIDER 150 'Genesi'



Taking home the MYS/Rina award which recognises the most

eco-friendly yacht at the show, this yacht was built by Italian yard Wider. At 46m, there's enough room for a beach club and a swimming pool, and she can run solely on battery power for a whole night.

Vanish



This 66.3m superyacht was the first project launch of 2016 for Dutch shipyard Feadship. Two helipads, a beach club, sun deck bar and extendable balcony in the owner's suite are just a few of the features that made this yacht a hit at the show.

Jetsetter





At 38.6m, this might not have been the biggest yacht at the show, but this is the first build in Sergei Dobroserdov's Monaco-based Dyanmiq's D4 series and for that reason, attracted no end of attention. The company collaborated with Italian fashion house Trussardi to ensure the interiors were on point.






