Dynamiq introduces first superyacht in collaboration with Porsche

Monaco-based shipyard <u>Dynamiq</u> has unveiled its first superyacht in the new range developed in cooperation with Studio F.A. Porsche. The first model, a 35-meter GTT 115 Hybrid, is currently under construction at the shipyard in Viareggio, Italy and will be presented at Monaco Yacht Show this September.



The new series of superyachts with Porsche DNA will range from 85 to 115 feet and blends racing-inspired performance with a fast-displacement, lightweight aluminium hull. Comfortable, high-speed cruising and transatlantic crossings are both easily achieved by these Grand Turismo Transatlantic superyachts. Each GTT yacht is easily customisable via Dynamiq's online configurator.



Performance wise the yacht is powered by twin 1213kW MAN engines paired with the latest Fortjes 5000 pods, meaning she can exceed a maximum speed of 21 knots and is capable of crossing the Atlantic with a range of 3,400nm.



A limited edition of only seven GTT 115 yachts will be manufactured, making it a truly unique collector's edition model. Prices start from $\leq 11,900,000$, with a production time of just 15 months from the date of order.
