

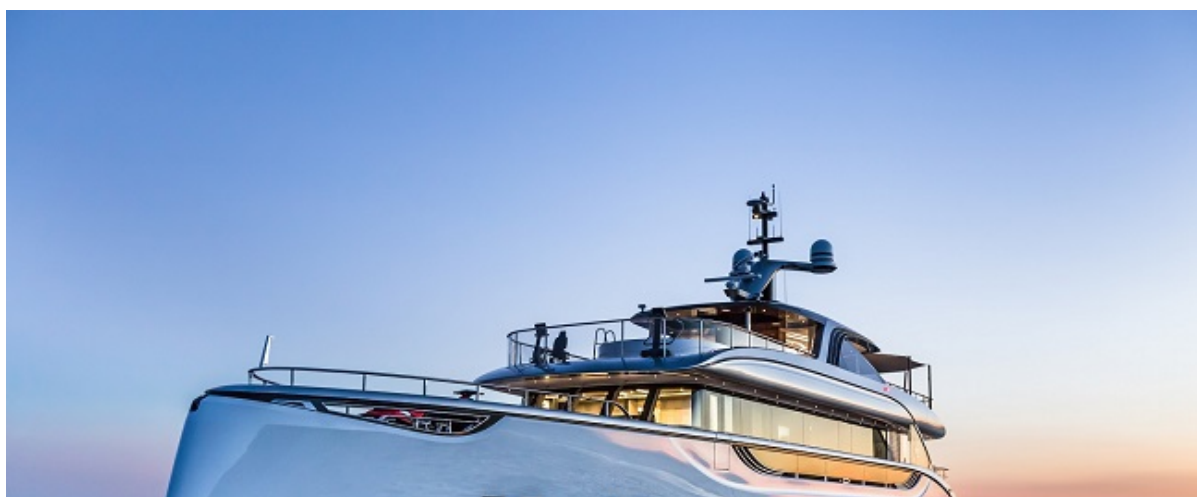

## Dynamiq Yachts – The new name in superyachts from Monaco starts a revolution with its Grand Touring series | YachtNews

**Dynamiq** has recently released its first **D4** motor yacht, ***Jetsetter***.

Launched in **September** and unveiled at the **2016 Monaco Yacht Show**, where she sparked huge interest both among industry professionals and the superyacht clientele, ***Jetsetter*** represents the first yacht of the “**Grand Turismo Transatlantic**” series, whose purpose is to convey the philosophy of Grand Touring cars in the nautical field, offering performance, luxury and range.





**Sergei Dobroserdov, Dynamiq Founder and CEO, explains:**  
*“Dynamiq’s goal is it to bring the highest quality standards and technology of **60-70 metre** superyachts to the **30-40m** segment. Aligned with our top-class partners we make things happen. Our yachts are the only all-rounders on the market, which come at a very manageable size and price. **Dynamiq** is the rational choice as it provides more comfort and functionality than the other yachts in this class.”*



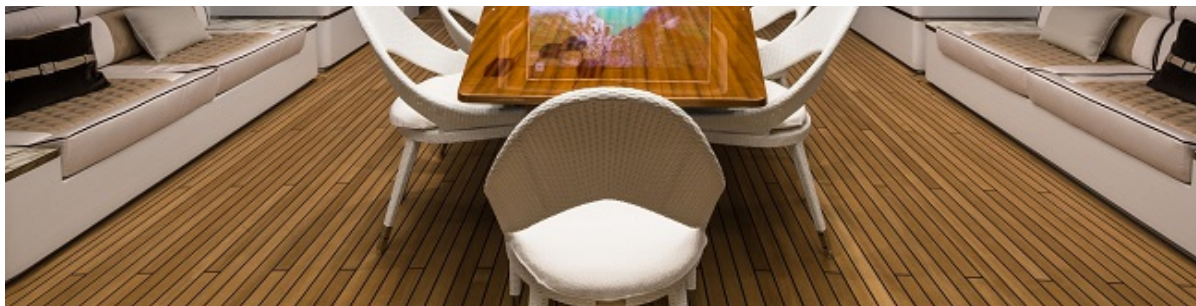
**Dynamiq** created a revolutionary configurator that allows its clients to customise a yacht right on the company’s website, from the

exterior paint scheme to the interior finish, technical equipment, tender, crew uniforms, and toys. The online configurator features full pricing for every element, while a running total gives the exact price and delivery date for the customised yacht.



**Jetsetter**, the first **D4** motor yacht, features exterior styling by **Dobroserdov Design**, while the interior design, which sports select furnishings and accessories from **Trussardi Casa**, was conceived by the London-based studio **Bannenber & Rowell**.





**Tommaso Trussardi**, CEO of **Trussardi Group**, comments: “We are very excited to have worked with **Dynamiq Yachts** on **Jetsetter**, a project that blends the craftsmanship of our **Trussardi Casa** creations with the avant-garde and futuristic technology of these yachts.”



On board, the **38.60m** all-aluminum vessel offers accommodation for up to 8 guests in four cabins, as well as six crew members in spacious quarters.

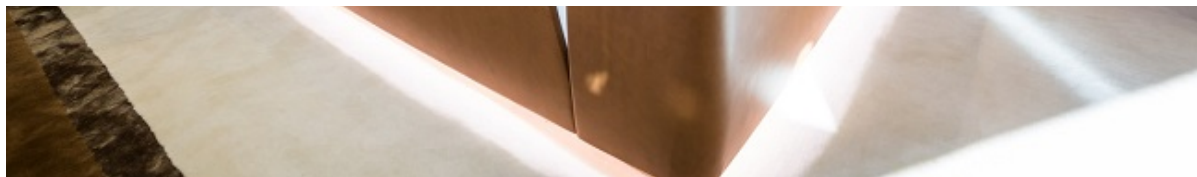
With a hull developed by **Azure Naval Architects** and optimized by

hydrodynamic specialists **Van Oossanen**, she boasts a highly efficient shape with a vertical stem.



Equipped with two **MAN V12-1800 1,324kW diesel** engines and **Fortjes 4000** pod drives with contra-rotating propellers, **Jetsetter** combines a maximum speed of **21 knots** with a remarkable **3,000nm** range at **10 knots**.





The yacht is listed for sale with **Burgess** at **14,545,000 Euros** and available for immediate delivery. Currently stationed in Marina di Carrara, **Italy**, she will head to **Florida** to make her US debut at the **Miami International Boat Show** in **February 2017**.
