39-meter "Jetsetter" From Dynamiq Yachts Launched

Dynamiq Yachts recently launched a cool-looking 39-meter luxury yacht called "Jetsetter". She has been launched just in time to make her debut at the upcoming Monaco Yacht Show (MYS). *Jetsetter* is part of the Dynamiq D4 series of yachts from this company. Her all-aluminium construction was fashioned to a design by Sergei Dobroserdov of the Dobroserdov Design Studio. The hull and hydrodynamic aspects were designed by Azure and Van Oossanen Naval Architects. The interior of *Jetsetter* was conceptualized and finished by the Bannenberg & Rowell Studio.



The interior has been optimized to sleep as many as eight guests onboard across four cabins. It appears all cabins are located on the lower deck with the master suite in the midships area of the hull. Two internal decks exist while an expansive open-air sundeck will be a particular hit with guests. The forward end of the sundeck plunges into a minimal design offering the opportunity to wrap the entire front area in a glass railing. Guests relaxing in this area will be able to be sitting or horizontal and still have almost unimpeded views forward.



Jetsetter has an underwater hull optimized by Van Oossanen Naval Architects that combines a relatively slim draft that is slippery through the water to allow it to be efficient. The propulsion is also different to the average craft of 39-meters. There are a pair of Fortjes propulsion pods that ensure power efficiency and maneuverability. Top speed with the set-up should be 21-knots while a range of 3,000 nautical miles at her efficient cruising speed should be attainable. This modern Grand-Touring style yacht will be available for showing at the Monaco Yacht Show (MYS).
