Porsche's \$11.9m Superyacht Is What Billionaire Dreams Are Made Of

The Roger Moore of the yacht world has arrived.

Porsche has made a rather dazzling entry into the world of yacht making, following the likes of [Mercedes-Benz](#) and [Aston Martin](#) and creating what has been christened the GTT 115 Hybrid.

The yacht, which is currently under construction at a shipyard in Northern Tuscany is slated to be unveiled at the Monaco Yacht Show in September this year.



Studio Porsche has exclusively designed both the interiors and the exterior of the yacht adding a few final flourishes which closely resemble the tail-end of a [911](#) (including that signature tail light).

Where it's unlike a 911 is when it comes to pretty much everything else. The interiors will be the ergonomic equivalent of a Georgian villa while the total power output could shame a jet-propelled dragster.



The yacht is powered by two MAN Diesel engines generating near 1700-bhp each. This power is then supplemented by two 45Kw generators which allows this thing to reach speeds up to 21 knots with a range of 6,296 km.

It's limited to just seven units, but don't look too crestfallen since each unit costs \$11.9m. Shore up by the dockside and just stay there, since no private residence could ever look this good.
