Yacht builder <u>Dynamiq Yachts</u> has officially launched its refit operations in the Antalya Free Zone, Turkey. The addition to its current services in the south of Turkey, marks the start of a new chapter in bespoke yacht refits for <u>Dynamiq</u>.

The first vessel to participate in the refit program is the 38.6-metre <u>Dynamiq</u> yacht <u>Spring</u>, previously known as *Jetsetter*. "This project will cover a wide range of refurbishments, from propulsion systems overhauls to interior upgrades and more. One of the refit's main jobs is the thorough maintenance of the pods and their gearboxes, led by accredited Reintjes technicians, guaranteeing quality and precision," concluded <u>Dynamiq Yachts</u>.
