
The Dynamiq GTT 165 is an innovative 50-meter superyacht that can comfortably accommodate 12 guests across six sumptuous staterooms including a beautiful owner's suite that comes with two side structural balconies, a desk, seating area and large ensuite bathroom with a freestanding bathtub. The GTT 165 boasts a unique interior style with an exclusive selection of furnishings and accessories from Italian fashion house Bottega Veneta.




Large sliding doors on the upper deck of the superyacht convert the area from a spacious indoor-outdoor space to a chic dining area. Dedicated to wellness, the aft sundeck features 360-degree views from the gym and plenty of space for a soothing yoga setup. The state-of-the-art spa center is located on the lower deck with direct access to the water.



Engineered in the Netherlands by the experts at Van Oossanen Naval Architects, the GTT 165 has a sturdy, fast-displacement hull built from an aluminum alloy. She can reach a maximum speed of 19 knots (23 knots with the Sport package). The yacht's long-distance autonomous range of 4,000 nm results in the ability to undertake multiple cruising seasons. The owner may opt for a hybrid propulsion system for ultimate efficiency and quiet operation.
