






As for the interior, the yacht boasts the Maldivian-inspired interior styling with an exclusive selection of furnishings and accessories from Bottega Veneta.







The aft sundeck is dedicated to wellness, with a 360-degree view gym and maximum space for fitness, while the state-of-the-art spa centre is found on the lower deck with direct access to the water.





The updated yacht now comes with a slightly faster maximum speed of 19 knots or 23 knots with the S version. Also, at the owner's request, a hybrid propulsion system can be chosen for ultimate efficiency and silent operation.
